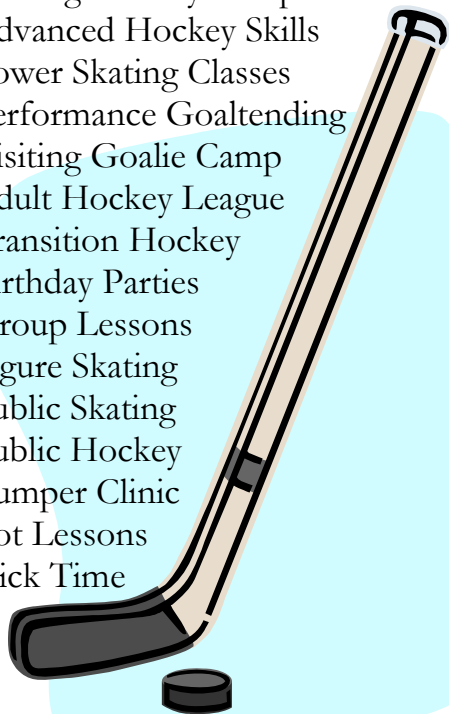

OUR PROGRAM

Our program gives participants with little or no experience an opportunity to learn the sport of ice hockey in a fun environment. At most sessions, participants are grouped by age and skill level and rotate through different stations. Players will develop skating, puck handling, passing and shooting techniques as well as an understanding of the game. Often with younger children, games will be played to teach specific skills.

REGISTRATION

Pre-registration and payment is required for all classes. Registrations will be accepted by mail or at any time in the rink office. NO refunds or make-up classes are provided. Late registrations, if accepted, will be charged on a pro-rated basis of \$20 per class.
